

BROPHY SUMMER SCHOOL 2010 ATHLETIC OPPORTUNITIES

In an attempt to improve the overall opportunities for athletes, we have changed the format for our football, basketball and baseball summer classes into legitimate sport camps. Varsity coaches will be conducting the camps, along with Brophy athletes, so the students get more hands-on attention. Skill work, conditioning, and game-situations will take place in each camp.

The following opportunities will be two-week camps. The First Session will be June 1– June 11. Session Two will be from June 14 – June 25. Tuition will be \$200 for a two-week session or \$350 if a student signs up for both two-week sessions. If a camper is only interested in athletics for the summer, they may sign up for 2 sports for the entire four weeks for each sport at \$650. If a camper signs up for both sessions, they may do so in the same sport or switch sports. For example, a student who loves basketball will be able to sign up for all four weeks of basketball. Since all the camps will stress individual attention, the second session will continue where the first session ended rather than repeat the first session.

A second example is the student who plays multiple sports. A 7th grader could sign up for baseball from 8:00 – 10:00 a.m. the first two weeks and then switch to basketball the last two weeks. The cost for this example would be \$350.

A third example is for the student that will only be able to take athletic summer school classes. The 6th grader who takes football in the morning from 8:00 – 10:00 a.m. and then basketball from 10:35 a.m. – 12:30 will pay \$350 for two weeks or \$650 for both football and basketball the entire four weeks.

BASKETBALL

Where: Brophy's gym (Robson Gymnasium)

Time:	Incoming 7 th – 8 th graders:	8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m. (boys only)
	Incoming 3 rd – 6 th graders:	10:35 a.m. – 12:30 p.m. (boys & girls eligible)

Emphasis: This camp will emphasize basketball fundamentals and competition. Ball-handling, rebounding, passing, defense, and shooting will be covered thoroughly during the two-week camp. In addition, we will instill each camper a better knowledge and appreciation of the game as well as a tougher mental approach to both preparation and competition.

Coaches:

Mr. Tony Fuller - Brophy's Head Varsity Basketball Coach and a Region Coach of the Year. Coach Fuller began his successful coaching career after playing for the Detroit Pistons. He has been the Head Coach at Pepperdine University and San Diego State University, along with being the Assistant Coach at Stanford and UCLA.

BASEBALL (boys only)

Where: Brophy baseball field (Opus Field)

Time:	Incoming 7 th & 8 th graders	8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.
	Incoming 3 rd - 6 th graders	10:15 a.m. – 12:00 p.m.

Emphasis: This camp will emphasize the fundamentals of baseball. Campers will receive daily instruction on fielding, hitting, running the bases, and throwing. Pitchers and catchers will get to work in the bullpen and in game situations. All campers will learn the proper mental approach to practice and game situations. Drills, game simulations and scrimmages will take place during this two-week camp.

Coaches:

Mr. Patick Higgins - Brophy's Varsity Assistant Coach - Brophy has been in the state championship game the past two years, winning the title in 2006. Coach Higgins has been with Brophy's varsity staff for the past six years after being the Head Varsity Coach and State 4A Champions at Thunderbird High School. Coach Higgins is a former catcher, current pitching coach and an excellent teacher of the game.

Mr. Jose Mendoza - Brophy's Head Freshman Baseball Coach. Coach Mendoza has been coaching baseball at Brophy for the past eleven years with the past three as the Head Freshmen Coach. A 1988 graduate from Brophy, Coach Mendoza has a lot of passion and knowledge of the game. Coach Mendoza has taught the summer baseball class the past five years.

FOOTBALL (boys only) Incoming 5th – 8th graders

Time: 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

Where: Brophy's fields at the main campus and new sport's campus

Emphasis: This camp will combine football skills with speed and conditioning workouts. Fundamental development at individual positions, proper footwork, throwing and catching the ball and other drills will be emphasized. Campers will also learn the mental approach to football through game situations and competition.

Coaches:

Mr. Andrew Molander- Brophy's Head Varsity Football Coach, 5A-1 State Football Champions 2005 & 2007, Big School Coach of the Year, and Region Coach of the Year. Coach Molander has been coaching football at Brophy for the past seven years, including being the Head Coach for the past three years. He played professional football for ten years before beginning his coaching career.

Mr. Brad Shear— Brophy's Head Freshman Football Coach. Coach Shear has been coaching for the past twenty two years, eleven at Brophy College Preparatory. Coach Shear's freshmen teams have won the league championship ten of his eleven years, including being undefeated last season. His overall record is now 94-6.

SOCCER (boys & girls) Incoming 3rd – 6th graders

Time: 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

Incoming 7th & 8th graders

Time: 10:15 a.m. – 12:00 noon

Where: Brophy's fields at the main campus and new sports campus

Emphasis: This camp will emphasize the fundamentals of soccer. Campers will work daily on ball skills. Offensive and Defensive instruction will be given. Scrimmage games and team drills will also be created to add fun to the camp.

Coaches: Ms. Barb Chura, Xavier's Head Varsity Soccer Coach, 5A-1 State Champions 2008-2010 and Big School Coach of the Year. She played Division 1 soccer at the University of Connecticut and has also been a long time successful club coach here in the Valley.

LACROSSE (boys only) Incoming 3rd – 8th graders

Time: 8:00 a.m. – 10:00 a.m.

Where: Brophy's fields at the main campus and new sports campus

Emphasis: This camp will emphasize the fundamentals of lacrosse. Campers will work daily on ball skills. Offensive and Defensive instruction will be given. Scrimmage games and team drills will also be created to add fun to the camp.

Coaches: Mr. Beau Pich, Brophy's Head Varsity Lacrosse Coach, State Lacrosse Champions 2007 & 2008, State Runner-Up 2009. Coach Pich played at the University of Maryland and has assisted at many top high school and university programs and camps before coming to Brophy last season.

The following athletic courses will remain similar to past years and be one hour in length. They are considered equal to an academic course when computing tuition prices.

SPEED AND STRENGTH

Where: This class will take place on Brophy's main and new sports campus

This course is designed to be a positive, character building, attitude changing experience with goals to improve overall athletic performance. Students will work on weightlifting fundamentals, speed fundamentals, core strengthening and stabilization, along with hard-work and mental discipline, while promoting human wellness, overall body balance and improve sport performance.

GIRLS: Incoming 7th & 8th graders Period 1

BOYS: Incoming 4th - 6th graders Period 1

Xavier coaches will teach the girls' classes. Mr. Gary Galante will oversee all of the classes and be the lead instructor for the boys' classes. All instructors are excellent teachers or certified experienced trainers.

WRESTLING (boys only 5-8 grade)

Period 4

This course is designed to stress good conditioning and fundamentals, including takedowns and pinning combinations. It is open to students entering fifth through eighth graders regardless of weight or experience.

Coaches:

Mr. Brad Frank - Brophy's Head Varsity Coach. Coach Frank has led the Brophy team the past two years to its highest ever state finishes, including the team quarterfinals this season. Five of his wrestlers placed in the top five in the state at this year's 5A-1 wrestling tournament. Coach Frank brings over ten years of coaching experience to the mat and is an exceptional motivator as well as teacher of wrestling technique and strategies.
